

Star Block

Materials Required:

Star Fabric:

one 6-1/2" center square
eight 3-1/2" squares

Background Fabric:

four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
four 3-1/2" squares



Star fabric



Star fabric, wrong side



Background fabric

1. With right sides together, place a 3-1/2" star fabric square on top of a 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" background rectangle. Line up raw edges, sew along the diagonal, see Fig. 1. Press back half of square along sewing line towards the corner. See Fig. 2. Trim excess fabric.

2. With right sides together, place a matching 3-1/2" star fabric square on top of the rectangle. See Fig. 3. Sew along the diagonal and press over as in step 1. See Fig. 4. Make four of Fig. 4.

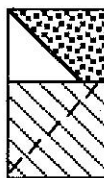

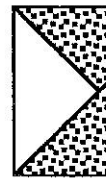
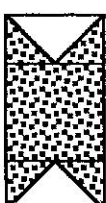

3. Sew a 3-1/2" background square to each end of the unit shown in Fig. 4, to create the strip shown as Unit A. Make two of Unit A.



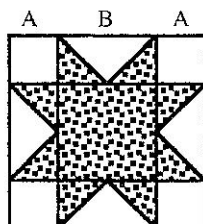

4. Sew two of the units in Fig. 4 to opposite sides of a 6-1/2" square of star fabric, to form Unit B. Make one Unit B.

6. Sew two of Unit A and one Unit B together, forming the Star Block.
